The course **A, San Pedro**, has open fairways and short yardage, therefore, woods and long irons are mainly used. Course **B, Ronda**, a fabulous course with narrow fairways and more difficult greens is surrounded by amazing houses and villas of the Spanish high society, and this uphill course leads to the Ronda mountains. Finally, course **C, Guadaiza**, although an easier course than B, there are many slopes and a few dog legs.
